Project Description

Qualified General Contractors (GCs) are invited to bid Removal and Replacement of the HVAC system on an existing CDOT building at 270 Ranney St.in Craig, CO. The project includes the Removal of a traditional roof mounted forced air gas burner system with a gas boiler and VRF system.

Minimum Requirements

Notice is hereby given to all interested parties that all firms will be required to meet all minimum requirements to be considered for this project. To be considered as qualified, interested firms shall have, as a minimum:

- 1. Provided General Contracting services within the last three (3) years for at least two (2) projects each in excess of \$500,000.00 (hard costs), utilizing the expertise present in their Colorado Office; and
- 2. Demonstrated specific General Contracting experience in projects of similar scope and complexity; and
- 3. Demonstrated bonding capability up to \$500,000.00 for an individual project coincidentally with current and anticipated workloads; provide letter from surety that affirms this capacity; and
- 4. Attended and signed in at the Mandatory Pre-Bid Conference
- 5. Not previously terminated by CDOT for non-performance or disqualified as a non-responsible bidder on a State Buildings contract or procurement.

Other Information

1. The contract shall be awarded with reasonable promptness by written notice to the low responsible bidder whose bid meets the requirements and criteria set forth in the

invitation for bids. In the event that all bids for a State Buildings project exceed available funds, as certified by the appropriate fiscal officer, the responsible officer is authorized, in situations where time or economic considerations preclude resolicitation of work of a reduced scope, to negotiate an adjustment of the bid price with the low responsible bidder in order to bring the bid within the amount of available funds; except that the functional specifications integral to completion of the project may not be reduced in scope, taking into account the project plan, design, and specifications and quality of materials. (Procurement Code 24-92-103 (7)

- 2. CDOT reserves the right to waive informalities or irregularities and to reject any and all Bids.
- 3. Preference shall be given to Colorado resident bidders and for Colorado labor, as provided by law.
- 4. The Principal Representative has determined that the entire project shall be substantially complete within 120 calendar days from the date of the Notice to Proceed and the project shall be finally complete, including the delivery of any or all guarantees and warranties, the submittal of sales and use tax payment forms, the completion of the final punch list and the calling for final inspection, within 44 calendar days, if applicable, from the date of substantial completion.
 - In accordance with Article 46 of the General Conditions of the Contract, Time of Completion and Liquidated Damages, failure to complete the work within the agreed number of calendar days shall be considered breach of contract and subject the bidder to liquidated damages to the extent specified in Article 54D of the General Conditions of the Contract. If this project is awarded under \$150,000 and a Purchase Order is used in lieu of a State Buildings Contract, then Liquidated Damages will not apply.
- 5. C.R.S. §24-92-202 applies to this Advertisement for Bid because it advertises a Colorado Department of Transportation public project, as defined by C.R.S. §24-92-201(5). All employees of the selected Bidder/Proposer/Vendor and all employees of any subcontractor who perform work under the contract issued pursuant to this Advertisement for Bid must be paid in accordance with the wage requirements of the federal Davis-Bacon Act, 40 U.S.C. §3141 et. seq., and Related Federal Acts, see also 40 U.S.C. §276(a), 29 C.F.R. Parts 1, 3, 5, 6, and 7, collectively referred to as "DBRA" and receive the minimum compensation as required by the DBRA. Any DBRA requirement that addresses the payment of wages, including when wages and overtime must be paid, will be required. Any requirement of DBRA that addresses reporting is not required. CDOT will require the contractor to fill out, sign and submit the Contractor Wage Compliance Certification with each Pay Application. The minimum DBRA wages to be paid are established by the U.S. Department of Labor. The applicable DBRA wages for the Public Project work to be performed pursuant to this Solicitation are attached as Appendix E. All subcontracts must contain this requirement and the selected Bidder/Proposer/Vendor shall, and shall ensure that all subcontractors, maintain and make available for review, inspection, and audit by the State all project records as are necessary to document compliance with applicable portions of the DBRA.
- 6. Labor and Material, Performance Bonds (if bid is over \$150,000), Certificates of Insurance, Labor Burden Spreadsheet will be required at contract signing.
- 7. For all projects with a total dollar value above \$150,000 Notice of Final Settlement is required by C.R.S. §38-26-107(1). Final Settlement, if required, will be advertised in the same location as the original solicitation.
- 8. Per C.R.S. §24-105-201 If the contract value is \$50,000 or greater a Bid Bond and Power of Attorney or Proposal Guaranty is required in an amount not less than 5% of the total Bid.
